Question forming is often difficult for foreign language speakers due to the mandatory word order inversion in English questions. This is especially true for Spanish speaking students, where word order inversion is uncommon. In each question, students are presented with a group of words. The object is to put these words in the correct order to form a syntactically correct question.

To make questions, we often put the verb before the subject. This is called inversion. If there is a question word (why, what, where, how, etc.), it goes before the verb. This is true for sentences with be, sentences that have auxiliary verbs (e.g.

Forming questions is one of the biggest challenges for English students. In this lesson for beginners, students practice forming basic questions with the verb "to be." They are also introduced to QwASVO (Question word, Auxiliary, Subject, Verb, Other), which is a learning tool that helps students form questions.

Forming Questions: Part 1: "Wh" questions with "to be."

Wh-questions. Wh-questions are questions which start with a word like what, when, where, which, who, whose, why and how. Question words.

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Questions with when, where, why. We form wh-questions with these words by putting the question word in front of a Yes/No question:

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
